INSTRUCTION – SELECTION OF INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIAL AND OTHER RESOURCES

It is the policy of Bemidji Area Schools to provide a wide-range of instructional materials that represent all levels of difficulty, diversity of appeal and different points of view. These materials must enrich and support the curriculum, be inclusive appropriate, and be age appropriate. The Superintendent will develop selection procedures for instructional materials and other resources. All teachers must use district textbook adoptions as their prime source of instructional material.
