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2010-2011 School Improvement SMART Goals:

- 1** At the Bemidji Alternative Education Center “ALL” students will increase their proficiency from 38.5% to 42% as measured by the Spring 2011 MCA II Reading assessments.

- 2** At the Bemidji Alternative Education Center, “ALL” students will increase their reading proficiency from 0% to 20% as measured by the Spring 2011 MCA II Math assessments.

- 3** All students enrolled at the Bemidji Alternative Education Center will increase their attendance for weekly appointment from 65% to 75% as measured by attendance data.

2010-2011 School Improvement Goals

School Improvement Goal #1:
At the Bemidji Alternative Education Center "ALL" students will increase their proficiency from 38.5% to 42% as measured by the Spring 2011 MCA II Reading assessments.
Baseline Data used To Select Goal:
Results of MCA II Reading data from spring 2010 indicate that 38.5% of ALL students tested met or exceeded proficiency. Thirteen students enrolled at the AEC were required to take the reading assessment.
Desired Result:
All AEC students will increase their proficiency on the MCA II tests.

Means to Achieve the School Improvement Goal

Staff Development Goal(s):
Core content teachers will improve the delivery of instruction enhancing student achievement in reading across the curriculum.
Staff Development Activities:
Teachers will be provided local, regional, and state in-service opportunities to improve student achievement in reading.
Evidence of Teacher Learning and Improved Student Performance:
A higher percentage of students will demonstrate proficiency on the MCA II reading test.

2010-2011 School Improvement Goals

School Improvement Goal #2:
At the Bemidji Alternative Education Center, "ALL" students will increase their reading proficiency from 0% to 20% as measured by the Spring 2011 MCA II Math assessments.
Baseline Data used To Select Goal:
Twenty-two students were required to take the MCA II Math assessment. 0% of those students passed the Spring 2010 MCA II.
Desired Result:
All AEC students will demonstrate proficiency on the MCA II Math test.

Means to Achieve the School Improvement Goal

Staff Development Goal(s):
Differentiated instruction techniques will be incorporated into daily instruction.
Staff Development Activities:
Teachers will be provided local, regional, and state in-service opportunities to improve student achievement in math.
Evidence of Teacher Learning and Improved Student Performance:
A higher percentage of students will pass the required MCA II exam in Mathematics.

2010-2011 School Improvement Goals

School Improvement Goal #3:
All students enrolled at the Bemidji Alternative Education Center will increase their attendance for weekly appointment from 65% to 75% as measured by attendance data.
Baseline Data used To Select Goal:
Students schedule appointments will individual teachers of the subject in which they are enrolled. During the 2010 school year, 65% of students were present at their scheduled time.
Desired Result:
Students will increase their attendance for weekly appointments with teachers.

Means to Achieve the School Improvement Goal

Staff Development Goal(s):
Core content teachers will improve delivery of instruction to include a variety of teaching strategies.
Staff Development Activities:
Teachers will be provided local, regional, and state in-service opportunities to improve student achievement in math.
Evidence of Teacher Learning and Improved Student Performance:
A higher percentage of students will attend appointments with their instructors at the AEC which will enhance student achievement.
