- acquire and use a wide-ranging vocabulary
- gather, comprehend, evaluate, synthesize, and report on information and ideas

Write critically and effectively

Through various opportunities for writing short response and extensive essays, students:

- write about what they read
- use evidence to construct effective arguments
- conduct original research in order to answer questions or solve problems.

- analyze a variety of cultures and viewpoints
- evaluate other points of view critically and constructively
- understand and aspire to a successful career path in a competitive world.
