# Choir Course Outline

## **Course Objectives:**

- 1. Students will learn to be confident in their singing voice, and be able to demonstrate proper vocal techniques.
- 2. Students will be able to read music, including note reading, rhythms, key and time signatures, etc.
- 3. Students will be exposed to choral elements, such as ensemble singing, blend, and vocal techniques.
- 4. Students will sing and perform a variety of music in both formal and informal situations, both individually and in an ensemble.
- 5. Students will grow a love and appreciation for music and its influence in society.

#### **Course Content:**

- 1. Vocal Health and Technique
- 2. Music Theory rhythms, note reading, key signatures, scales, vocabulary, etc.
- 3. Solfege and Sight Singing
- 4. Music History
- 5. Cooperative/Ensemble Learning
- 6. Performance Etiquette

## **Course Projects:**

- 1. Two formal concerts, in Quarters 2 and 4
- 2. Daily preparation and rehearsal for concerts
- 3. Two tests on course content, in Quarters 1 and 3
- 4. Various worksheets and daily exercises on course content

#### **Grading:**

45% Concert/Tests

45% Daily Points (Participation, Behavior)

10% Worksheets
