Central Elementary Education and Title I Services

In 2015-2016, Central Title staff and Principal Welte notice a busier time with more students, additional classrooms, and a combination (split) 3-4 class. Central Elementary serves a large number of transitional students, therefore, promote a safe haven for students to feel welcome and comfortable. Having the shared Title I teacher (non-public and Central) is very helpful.

Title I staff assist students with math and reading. Family Engagement events include "I Love to Read" the week of February 22-26, 2016. Parents, grandparents, and others read to students. Each day, staff and students dress for the special theme of the day (Dr. Seuss, as an example). Also, in the fall, Central featured an evening event, "Math with Muffins", where classroom teachers each gave a presentation about mathematics and families were served muffins.

2015-2016 Assessments

District Assessment Coordinator, Kathy Palm, shares information on testing through the school year. Students in grades K through 1 are assessed and can be progress monitored through AIMSweb, with the non-public schools (Heartland Christian Academy, St. Mark's, and St. Philip's) included this year. Students in grade 2 take the NWEA MAP test. Those in grades 3-11 participate in the Minnesota Statewide testing, taking the MCA-III or MTAS. Parents will receive links to spring testing item samplers and to Pearson Perspective.

Parents were given a copy of the 2016-2017 Family Engagement Plan and asked to review their copy, then bring revision suggestions to the next meeting. Also, an invitation to join Debbie Landvik's (MDE) Title I Family Engagement Training Feb. 25 in Bemidji.
