Solway Education and Title I Services

Solway Elementary is a unique school, being smaller and unified. The grade configuration is one class per level 1-5, plus two multi-levels; 1-2 and 3-4.

The new Title I teacher is Heather Sande and in 2015-16 Nancy Neis will take over for Denise Johnson. The Solway Title I program runs school-wide, with staff working to improve students' reading and math skills. Title I funds also provide for supplies towards supplemental instruction, books, computers, and family engagement activities. As a school-wide Title 1 Program, all Solway students benefit.

One of the goals in the Solway Elementary school-wide Improvement Plan is to provide more individualized instruction in flexible, small groups. These groups change throughout the school year as the needs of students change. Title 1 staff may help students by giving extra instruction in small groups, either within the regular classroom or in a quieter setting outside the regular classroom. Students may also get extra help in the regular classroom if they need help doing their reading and/or math assignments. Title 1 funded staff also provide assessments and/or screenings.
