### **J.W. Smith Education and Title I Services**

This elementary school provides intervention services for both math and reading. Every day, 36-40 pupils per staff member are served with intensive group intervention for four to five students. Intensive 30-minute reading lessons are given through Leveled Literacy Intervention and Reading Recovery teachers. Plus, five paraprofessionals are on duty assisting students with math and reading in the classroom. For guided math and reading, a few students are pulled out. Students' progress is monitored by graphing growth results from fall, winter and spring.

In December 2015, J.W. Smith will feature a read-in called "Flurry of Books". This event involves parents and students joining together for an afternoon in mid-December. Family members are invited to come to the school to read to their child. This activity usually lasts for 1 full hour and it is done from about 2:00 until the end of the day. Every child in grades K-5 receives a book purchased for their grade level by Title I. The children take the books home with them and the families and students are served a special cookie treat.
