

Bemidji Curriculum Review

Curriculum Review Committee:

The principals select the Curriculum Review Committee members to represent every grade and school, special education, and Title I for each subject being reviewed. The committee members meet after school as a whole group and by elementary, middle, and secondary level. Members are responsible for reporting back to their schools and fellow teachers and sharing other teachers' input at these meetings. Members review and pilot curriculum materials, attend presentations and trainings during the year of review, and align the selected curriculum to the Minnesota Academic Standards. In April the committee chairs present their process and curriculum selections to the District Curriculum Committee. All materials are by May 1, and the committee chairs present their completed Course Outcomes to the Bemidji School Board in June.
