

STUDENT PERSONNEL
ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY FOR EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES
BEMIDJI MIDDLE SCHOOL

Participation in extra-curricular activities is a privilege granted to a student, it is not an inherent student right. It is the belief of the Board of Education that such participation must be earned based on academic performance.

To be scholastically eligible for any extra-curricular activity, a student must maintain a minimum of a 2.0 Grade Point Average (GPA). The minimum requirement of a 2.0 cumulative GPA will be put into effect following the conclusion of the first quarter of the 7th and 8th grade year. Scholastic eligibility will be determined at the end of each quarter to the remainder of the school year. Students forfeit their eligibility for three weeks as 8th grade students and two weeks as 7th grade students if they do not maintain a minimum Grade Point Average of 2.0 cumulative.

Students and parent/guardian may apply for a contractual agreement with the Activities Coordinator in an effort to become scholastically eligible. This agreement includes sustained progress (weekly grade checks assuring a 2.0 cumulative GPA average) for meeting the middle school requirements. This agreement will be in effect after the period of ineligibility until the student/athlete reaches a 2.0 cumulative GPA.
