The teachers in Alpha Pod are committed to helping you have a successful school year!

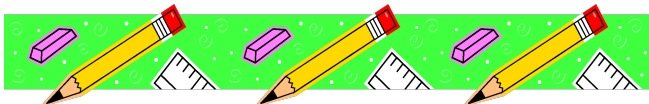
Let us introduce ourselves:
