Learning Objectives:


- By the end of 8th grade in Language Arts at BMS, students will be able to:

 - utilize course content to gain a deeper understanding of other personal and/or cultural perspectives.




Writing Requirements: Personal Memoir Five Paragraph Research Essay Five Paragraph Persuasive Essay

Grading Criteria:
