Students will have the option to take this elective class in 8th grade. We will be following the Minnesota Art Standards to guide our learning, and will be learning using traditional materials, our main material being wood. Projects could include (depending on supplies available) canoe paddles, wood signs, ring toss games, and wood spoons. Students will be asked to study safe use of tools such as scroll saws, planer, bandsaws, belt sanders, drill press, power drills, dremels and other woodworking tools, and will be expected to follow all safety protocols using these tools.

Course Learning Goals (based on MN Arts Standards):

Grading:

- There will be 2 categories in the grade book: **DAILY WORK & ASSESSMENT**
- **The DAILY WORK Category** will be for communication about whether or not a student is completing assignments. This category will be worth 10% of the grade because it is formative and based on work completion. *(All daily work assignments will be out of 5 points.)*
- **The ASSESSMENT Category** will be worth 90% of the grade because these are times when we check to see if a student is showing mastery of the course learning goals (similar to a test).
- In class, for **assessments** students will be scored on a 4 point scale for simplicity and clarity
- In Skyward, the 4 point scale will be converted into points to make it work with the skyward grading scale (see example below)

- Student Scores for Assessments in Skyward will be aligned with the learning goals listed above (same titles).
- Students are allowed to work on ALL skills or learning goals all quarter. Even if a skill grade is entered in skyward, students can re-try that learning goal as many times as they would like UNTIL THE LAST WEEK OF THE QUARTER. NO RETRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED THE LAST WEEK OF A QUARTER. Most scores will only go up, however, a goal like keeping a good portfolio could go down if a student neglects their portfolio later in the quarter.
