- Read often to your child and have fun while doing so!
- Snuggle when you read.
- Don't skip your regular reading time.
- Read and reread the stories your children request.
- Enjoy the illustrations and graphics.
- Be patient when your child is reading aloud.
- Read aloud together with your child.

Using Computers

- Play with objects and characters on the screen to help your child learn the alphabet, simple words, and rhyming skills.
- Record your child reading, and play back the recording so he/she can hear the 'performance'.
- Write simple sentences and make up stories.
- Add pictures and characters to original stories.
- Make and print books. Save them and put them on a bookshelf for display and preservation.
- Make slide shows, and show them to relatives & friends.
