Early Childhood Screening

In order for your child to start kindergarten in any Minnesota public school (s)he must participate in early childhood screening. Screening includes vision, hearing, height, weight, speech/language and developmental observations. We offer these screenings throughout the year at various locations. Ideally children are screened between the ages of 3 1/2-4 years old or earlier, if parents have concerns about their child's development. There is no cost for the screening.
